- a. Stop lines at a stop sign

- a. One-way traffic only
- b. Turning area
- c. Mini roundabout

3



- a. Do not enter the marked area if you can avoid doing so
- b. You may overtake if the road is clear
- c. Parking area

4



- a. Centre line
- b. No overtaking or crossing at any time
- c. Hazard warning line

5



- a. Do not cross or straddle
- b. No overtaking
- c. Dual carriageway ahead

6



- a. Warning of 'Give Way' just ahead
- b. Warning of 'Stop' sign just ahead
- c. Warning of minor road ahead

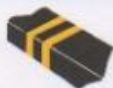
- a. Urban clearway. No stopping
- b. No waiting at any time
- c. No waiting during the working day

8



- a. Do not enter the marked area unless your exit is clear
- b. School — Keep clear
- c. Special road surface safety experiment

9



- a. No waiting at any time
- b. No loading or unloading during every working day and additional times
- c. Waiting allowed for 20 minutes maximum

10



- a. Zebra crossing
- b. Pelican crossing
- c. Level crossing

3



- a. Get in lane
- b. Underpass ahead

- d. Lane open to traffic facing the signal

- a. Move to the left lane
- b. Leave the motorway at next exit
- c. Motorway bends sharply left ahead
- d. Use the hard shoulder

5



- a. Cross over to another lane
- b. Hazard in lane as shown
- c. Plant crossing motorway
- d. Lane closed to traffic facing sign

6



- a. End of lane closure
- b. End of temporary restriction
- c. End of temporary advisory speed limit
- d. End of National speed limit

7



- a. Temporary maximum speed limit
- b. Temporary minimum speed limit
- c. Mandatory speed limit
- d. Hazard 50 metres ahead

8



- a. White lining ahead
- b. Lane closed ahead
- c. Right hand traffic give way to left hand lanes
- d. Stop in right lane

9



- a. End of bridge over motorway
- b. No motorway traffic allowed
- c. End of motorway
- d. End of motorway traffic prohibition
